First Aid

Statement of Intent

At Bizzie Lizzies Nursery, we believe that all children should be protected from harm and that *Every Child Matters*.

We work in partnership with children, parents, and the wider community to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all children, giving them the very best start in life.

All staff are trained to administer first aid to children and adults if needed. At least one member of staff with a current paediatric first aid qualification is always present on the premises and accompanies children on outings.

Procedures

Staff Training

- All staff hold a current **paediatric first aid certificate**, updated every three years.
- Two members of staff additionally hold a **First Aid at Work certificate**.
- Training includes first aid relevant to infants and young children.

First Aid Kits

Our first aid kits:

- Contain appropriate content to meet children's needs.

- Are checked regularly by the designated member of staff (**Anna Davies**).
- Are easily accessible to staff but kept out of children's reach.
- Are located in each area of the nursery.

At the time of admission:

- Written parental permission for emergency medical advice/treatment is obtained.
- Parents must sign and date their written approval.
- Plasters may be administered to clean cuts or grazes where appropriate.

First Aid Kit Contents

Our kits comply with the **Health and Safety (First Aid) Regulations 1981** and include:

- 1 First Aid guidance booklet
- 20 Sterile adhesive dressings (assorted sizes, hypoallergenic)
- 2 Sterile eye pads
- 4 Triangular bandages
- 6 Medium wound dressings (individually wrapped, sterile, with bandages attached)
- 2 Large wound dressings (as above)
- 5 Non-adherent dressings
- 1 Roll self-adhesive tape
- 2 Pairs of disposable gloves
- 1 Pair of round-ended scissors
- 10 Packs of sterile water
- 1 Finger bandage with applicator

Additional supplies in each box:

- 2 Pairs disposable plastic gloves (PVC or vinyl)
- 1 Disposable apron
- 1 Children's forehead strip thermometer

Note: No sprays, antiseptic wipes, creams, lotions, tablets, or medicines are kept in the first aid kit.

Emergency Procedures

- No un-prescribed medication is administered to children, parents, or staff.
- Parents sign a consent form on registration allowing staff to:
 - Seek emergency medical advice/treatment.
 - Take their child to the nearest Accident & Emergency unit for examination/treatment/admission, with parents notified immediately and on their way.

Accident Reporting

- Accident sheets are securely stored and easily accessible to staff.
- All staff are trained to complete them correctly.
- Records are reviewed regularly to identify potential or actual hazards.
- Parents must sign accident records when collecting their child.
